We are very thankful to have been invited to attend Howden Show as Honorary President 2026.

As 7th generation residents of Howden, we have always loved attending Howden Show, enjoying the fairground attractions, petting the animals, watching the entertainment, taking part in the creative competitions, and admiring the talents of local people. Also, of course trying the delicious food freshly prepared by the catering stalls.

Because of our Howden heritage, we have always wanted to help our community by volunteering our time to support local organisations, like Howden Town Council and the charity Howden Preschool. Our time volunteering, has meant that we have often helped with manning stalls at Howden Show, something we have always enjoyed doing.

If you are wondering who we are – here is a little bit about us. Over the years we have campaigned for Road Safety in Howden especially the need for a new road to be built to remove the heavy traffic from Howden's small streets. When my son Harrison was diagnosed with Autism and a learning disability, our family became part of a new community, one that cares and supports some of the most incredible people that we have ever had the privilege to call friends. Being part of a disabled and carer community, made us realise that Howden needed to become more inclusive to help disabled people and their carers to access our town and enjoy our fantastic shops, hospitality, beautiful parks and open spaces. We decided to start the campaign, Project-Loo, and fund raised for a Changing Places to be built in Howden, so disabled people and their carers could visit Howden and access toilet facilities the same as everyone else. With the help of Howden Town Council, the Howden Rotary Club and the people of Howden a Changing Place was built, and on behalf of the disabled community, we are incredibly grateful.

Changes for Howden Show 2026

Ticket prices have been held at the same price for the last 6 years therefore the Trustees have made the difficult decision, which has not been taken lightly, to increase the ticket prices this year.

Over the last 6 years inflation has increased by 19% which has been absorbed over the years, however, this is no longer possible.

Due to poor weather during the 2024 and 2025 Show weekends, a loss has been reported for the last two financial years. While the trustees have ensured that there are sufficient funds for Howden Show to continue in the short term, it is necessary to recoup some of the funds to ensure that Howden Show continues for the next 150 years.

The introduction of The Terrorism (Protection of Premises) Act 2025, also known as Martyn's Law, this year means that Howden Show is a "Qualifying Event" which means that there will be enhanced security checks at the entrances and increased boundary fencing.

The biggest change which visitors to Howden Show will notice is the ticketing system. To aid Howden Show's incident response procedures it is necessary to know the exact number of people present on The Show Field at any one time, to do this an electronic ticketing system is being introduced. This is a purchase in advance system which will require a QR code to be presented at the gate for scanning and will also be scanned again upon departure.

A ticketing system has been carefully selected which meets the administrative needs of Howden Show while minimising the financial burden to its visitors.

Park and Ride for Howden Show 2026

New for 2026 is a free park and ride service running from PA's car park on Station Road to the Market Place, the bus will be running all day from 08:30 – 12:30 and 13:30 – 17:30 on a continual loop.

Access to the secure car park will be controlled by our volunteers and then it is a short walk to The Show entrance passed Bishop's Manor.

Direction signs will be displayed around the town to help visitors find the car park.

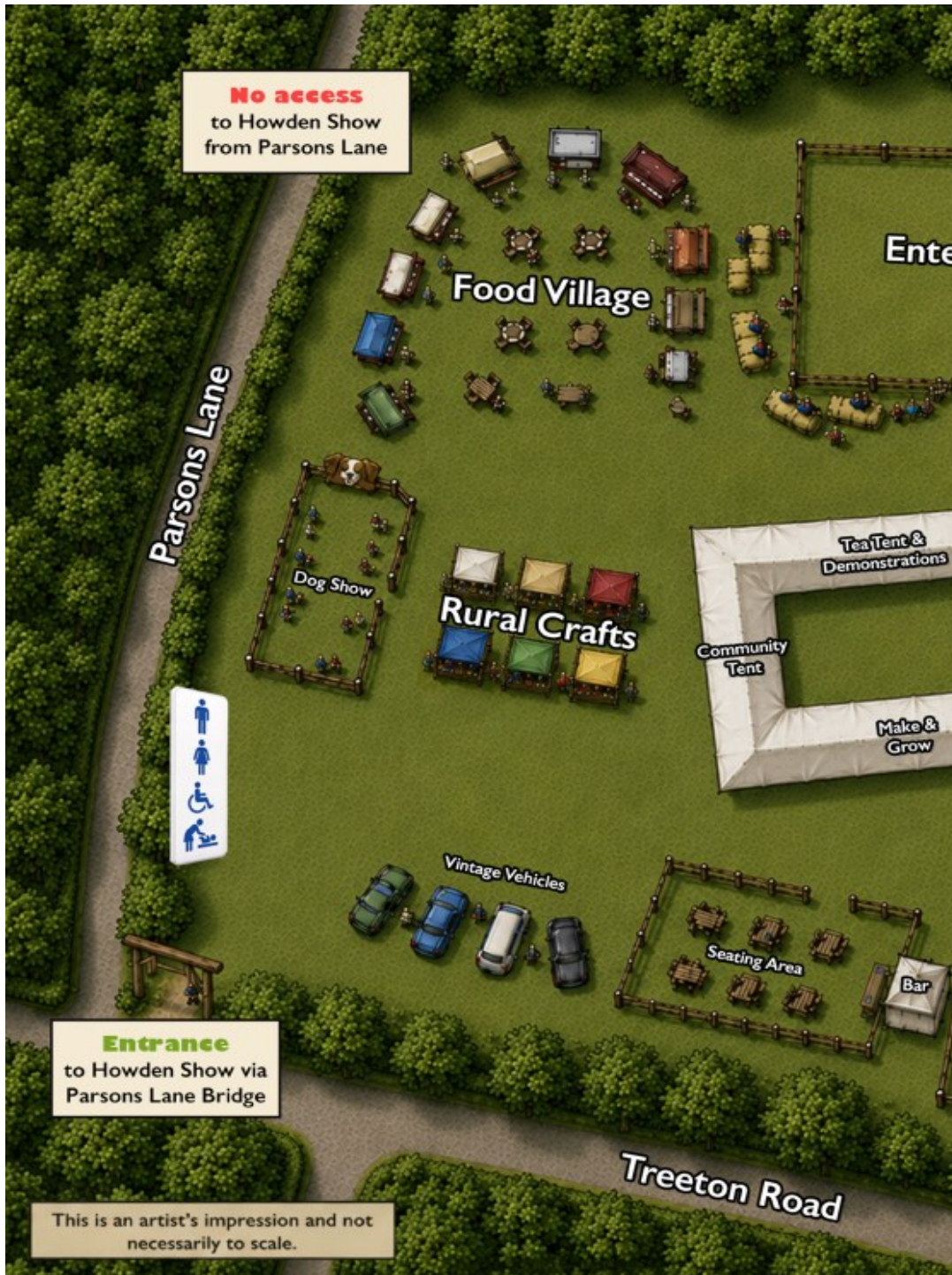

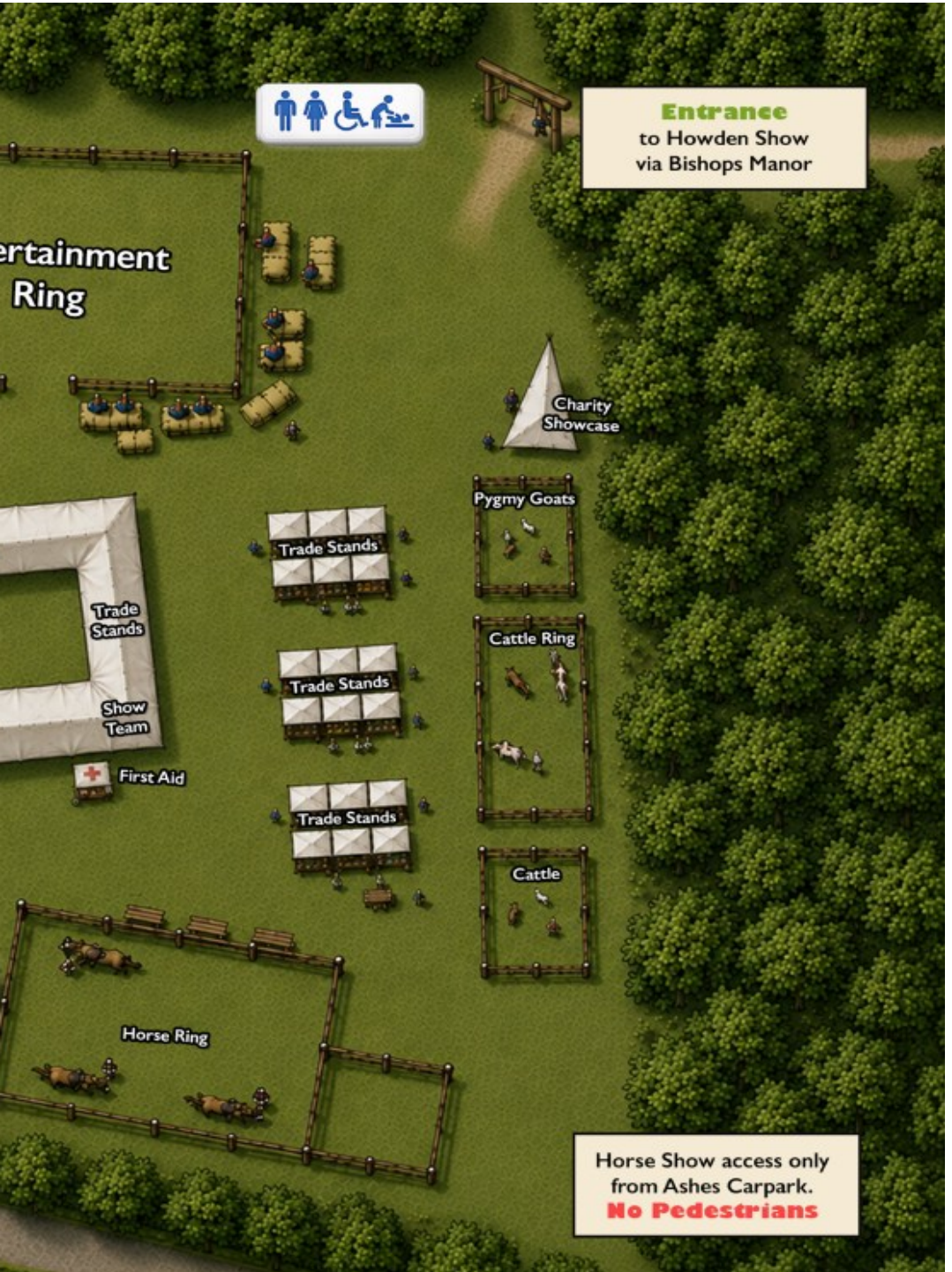

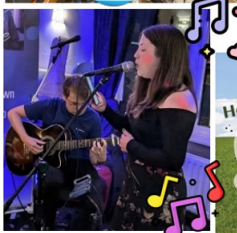

Howden Agricultural and Horticultural Show is a registered charity (no.1146788) which holds an annual show to promote agriculture and horticulture in the local community.

In addition to this, the show awards grants to individuals and organisations who meet the following criteria:

- Grant funding must be spent on projects which meet the show's charitable objective of "Promotion/advancement, for the benefit of the public, of agriculture, horticulture, countryside and rural pursuits"

Additional information:

- Applications are accepted throughout the year.
- Grants are awarded up to £2000 per application.
- Spending of the grant must commence within 6 months of the award and fully spent within 2 years.
- Repeat applications can not be made within 1 year of a successful grant.
- Applications can be for specific projects or funding towards ongoing costs.
- Capital expenditure over £500 to have 3 quotes/costing options.
- Applications can be for the full amount or a contribution towards a project which has alternative funding
- Full breakdown of costings is required in all grant applications.
- Successful applicants will be required to provide a report within 6 months of the funding being agreed stating how the grant has been spent and in time for the next annual show.

Entry fee is £4 per class in advance and £7 on the day. You must ALSO purchase a show ticket for every person wishing to access the show. **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Tickets are available to purchase in advance via our website. Entry tickets **CANNOT** be purchased from the Horse Secretary on the day..

Advance entries will be accepted up to Thursday 2nd July and must be made using the online form, entries received after this date will be liable for the on the day fees.

Entries will be taken on the day until 9.50am for classes 1 & 2 and before completion of the preceding class for all other classes, space permitting.

Class Sizes

Due to space limitations on both the show field and the parking area pony & small breed classes are limited to 15 entries and horse & large breed classes are limited to 12 entries.

PRE-ENTRY IS RECOMMENDED.

Note on vehicles: Vehicles over 7.5 tonnes cannot access the parking area and will not be admitted onto the site.

5. Any person wilfully creating a disturbance will be expelled from the showground.
6. Officials and competitors only to be allowed in the ring.
7. Horses are not allowed on the main show field outside of the competition ring, collecting area and horse walk.
8. By entering any class, competitors agree to their name being published in advertising and results, in accordance with The Data Protection Act.
9. All riders **MUST** wear correctly secured safety hats, in accordance with British standards

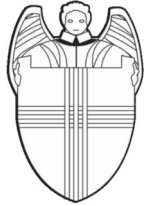

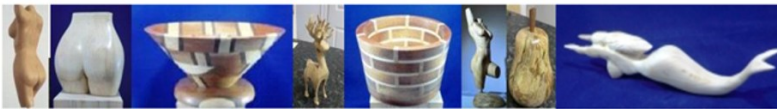
